



100 Years Ago: The British in the Holy Land

From the Ordnance Survey of Jerusalem 1864/65 and work of the explorers of the Palestine Exploration Fund from 1866, the authorities and members of Christ Church (Barclay, Schick, Chaplin, and others) played an important role in promoting the study of ancient Jerusalem.

Dr Gibson who has researched the history of archaeology in the Holy Land and Jerusalem in particular, will look at some of the archaeological remains uncovered beneath the Church compound that were investigated by the PEF explorers, notably a subterranean tunnel, and other remains associated with the palace of Herod the Great.
